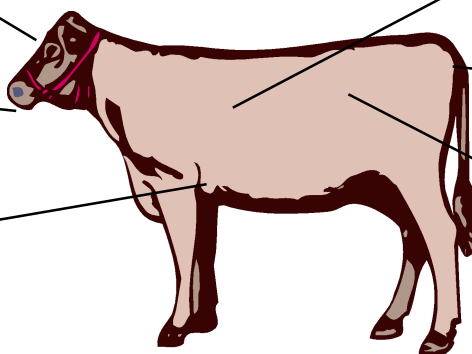
Check the MM's and CRT

Problems Noted:

Once a problem has been identified, it is advisable to contact a veterinarian. If any of the following occur, contact a veterinarian immediately:

1. The skin tents remain raised/tented.
2. The temperature, respiratory and heart rates remain abnormally high or low.
3. Routine treatments do not solve the problem.
